To whom it may concern,

We are longtime (30 years) residents of Kirsi Circle and we are writing in regards to the Kirsi Circle water main/ sidewalk project.

As long as we have lived here we have rarely seen anyone walking on the old sidewalks. We both walk quite a bit, in our neighborhood and the Fairview/Dana Drive neighborhood. We never walk on the sidewalks, always walking in the street and most other walkers are doing the same. Kirsi Circle is a very quiet street. We do not think there is any safety issues in regard to traffic.

We do not feel it is necessary to invest such a large amount of public money (estimated \$700,000) that could be used elsewhere. In an ideal world, where money would not be an issue, maybe a new/replaced sidewalk would be great? But that is not the world we live in. It seems irresponsible to spend a very large amount of money for a sidewalk on a quiet side street while most of a very busy Main Street does not have sidewalks. We think the \$700,000 could be spent more wisely.
