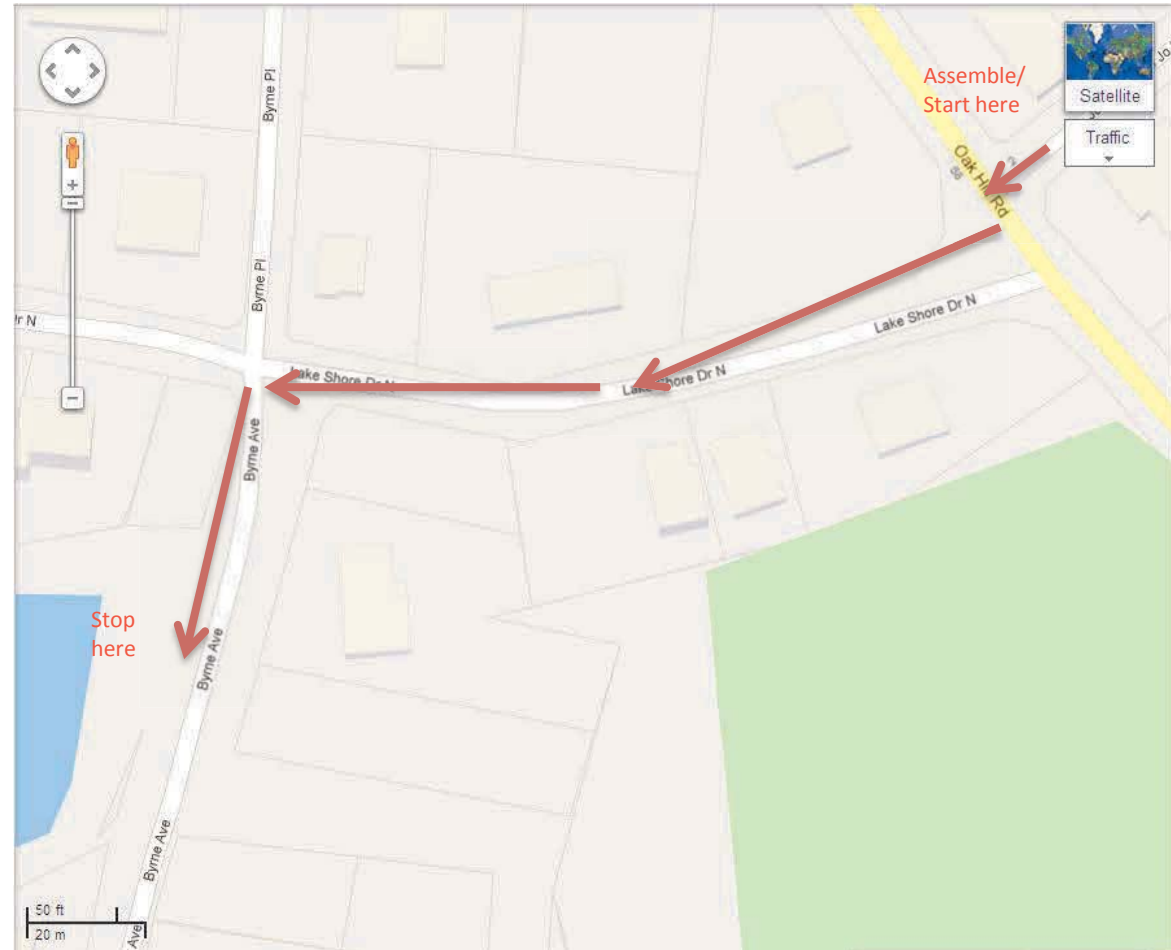

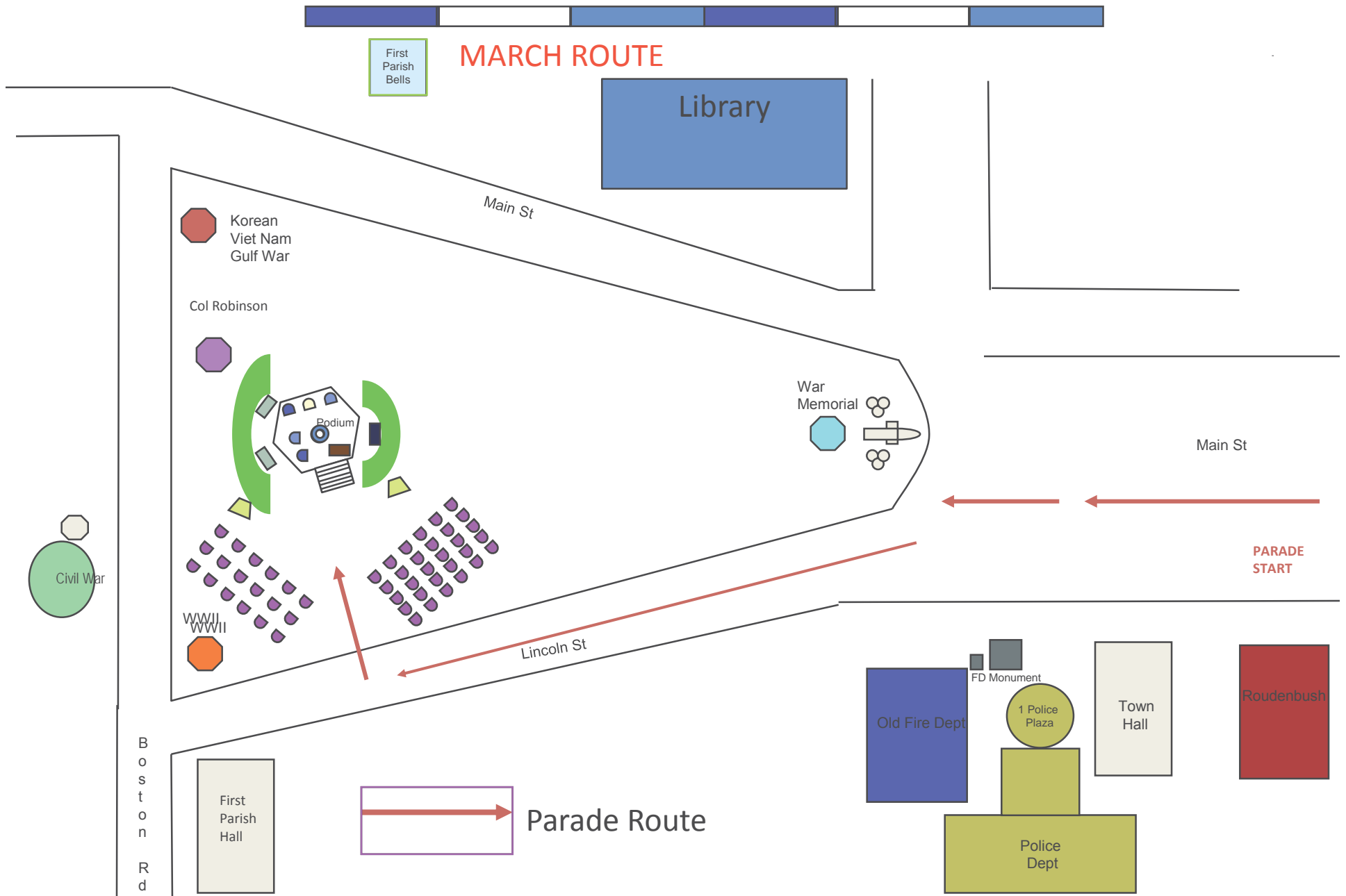
Westford Center Parade
