GLHA Community Survey

Residents were asked to indicate the three most important issues for each of the following categories as part of the Greater Lowell Health Alliance community survey:

Community Health Issues

(ex: substance use, cancer, diabetes, mental health, etc)

Community Safety Issues

(ex: discrimination, domestic violence, property crime, etc)

Community Resources

(ex: access to mental health services, affordable housing, etc)

We will be reviewing and utilizing the survey responses of Westford residents to determine key priority areas for this Westford-specific CHA/CHIP process.

Westford Respondents: Community Health Issues

“From the list, which three issues are most important to you?”

- Lung & breathing health
- Muscle & bone health (osteoporosis, injuries/fracture)
- **Heart health (hypertension, heart disease)**
- Autoimmune health (Type 1 diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, multiple sclerosis)
- **Mental health (depression, anxiety, PTSD, eating disorders)**
- Pregnancy health (prenatal care, mortality, childbirth)
- Infant & child health (infant mortality, breastfeeding, vaccination, childhood diseases)
- Reproductive/sexual health (pregnancy prevention, PCOS, STIs)
- **Environmental health (insect illness, lead exposure, air quality)**
- Hearing, vision, and mobility impairments
- Alzheimer’s disease and related dementias
- Substance use disorder (opioids, cocaine)
- Alcohol use disorder
- **Cancer**
- Type 2 diabetes
- Nutrition
- HIV/AIDS
- **COVID-19**
- Other infectious disease (tuberculosis, Hep C, flu)

Westford Respondents: Community Safety Issues

“From the list, which three issues are most important to you?”

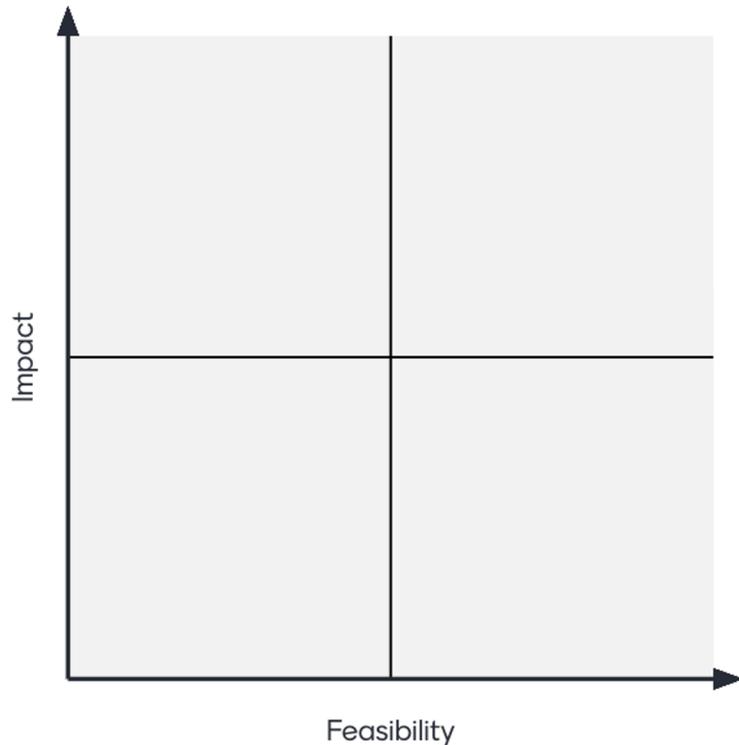
- **Discrimination based on race**
- Discrimination based on sex/gender
- Discrimination based on immigration status
- Discrimination based on class/income
- Discrimination based on sexuality
- Discrimination based on age
- **Domestic violence**
- **Sexual assault/rape**
- Other violent crime (i.e. assault)
- Illegal drug sales
- Gang activity
- Human trafficking (for example, labor trafficking)
- Property crimes (vandalism, theft, etc)
- **Unsafe/illegal gun ownership**
- **Unsafe driving**
- Bullying

Westford Respondents: Community Resources

“From the list, which three resources are most important to you?”

- **Access to healthy food**
- **Access to mental health services**
- Accessibility for people with disabilities
- **Affordable, safe housing**
- Emergency housing
- Dental services
- **Emergency health services**
- Preventative health services (like physicals, screenings, etc.)
- **Public education**
- Affordable childcare
- Reliable high-speed internet access
- Eye care
- Public transportation (like buses)
- Public parks
- Services for adolescents
- Services for older adults
- Services for veterans
- Substance use prevention
- Substance use treatment
