

Chapter 33: Legal Affairs

§ 33.1. Actions against the Town.

The Selectmen shall, with the assistance of Town Counsel, institute, prosecute and defend any and all claims, actions and proceedings to which the Town is a party or in which the interests of the Town are or may be involved.

§ 33.2. Authority to settle certain claims. [Amended 3-6-65 STM Art. 2]

The Selectmen may, subject to the approval of the Town, settle or compromise any claim, action, suit or other proceeding made or instituted by them in behalf of the Town. They may settle or compromise, without such approval, any such claim, action, suit or proceedings which does not involve more than \$1,000. Subject to appropriation therefor, they may settle any claim, action, suit or other proceeding against the Town.
