### On Street Parking Violation § 199-12 Code of Westford

- The Town of Westford By-law Code prohibits on street parking during the months of November through March between the hours of 1:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.
- The Town of Westford By-law Code prohibits the parking of vehicles in a way that impedes the removal or plowing of snow or ice.

No person shall park a vehicle as described above and vehicles found parked in violation of the provisions of this section shall be ticketed and may be moved by or under the direction of an officer, at the expense of the owner.

## WESTFORD CODE

### § 199-12. General prohibitions.

No person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places, and vehicles found parked in violation of the provisions of this section shall be ticketed and may be moved by or under the direction of an officer, at the expense of the owner:

- A. Within an intersection.
- B. Upon any sidewalk.
- C. Upon any crosswalk.
- D. Upon the roadway in a rural or sparsely settled area.
- E. Upon the roadway in a business or residential district where parking is permitted unless both wheels on the right side of the vehicle are within twelve (12) inches of the curb or edge of the roadway.
- F. Upon any roadway where the parking of a vehicle will not leave a clear and unobstructed lane at least ten (10) feet wide for passing traffic.
- G. Upon any street or highway within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant.
- H. Upon or in front of any private road or driveway without the consent of the owner of said private road or driveway.
- I. In front of any public driveway.
- J. Upon any street or highway with twenty (20) feet of an intersecting way, except alleys.
- K. Upon any way in such a manner as to impede the removal or plowing of snow or ice.
- L. No person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in his name, other than one acting in an emergency, to be parked on any street for a period of time longer than one (1) hour between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during November, December, January, February and March.
- M. In any area designated as and specifically marked as an area reserved for handicapped persons.
- N. In or upon any area designated and marked as a fire lane.
- O. In any area specifically displaying official signs prohibiting parking.
