PETITION TO PLACE AN ARTICLE ON TOWN MEETING WARRANT

We, the undersigned registered voters of the Town of Westford, hereby petition the Board of Selectmen to place the following article within the warrant (agenda) of the next Town Meeting* in accordance with Chapter 39, Section 10 of the Massachusetts General Laws:

To see if the Town will vote to amend the capital appropriation proposed for the design of the Boston Road Reconstruction project (Article 8, March 24, 2018 Annual Town Meeting) to add to the scope of work an ornamental traffic signal at the intersection of Boston Road and Main Street, and to raise and appropriate, borrow, or transfer from available funds, or any combination thereof; a sum of money (\$55,000) to pay for the engineering services needed for this amendment.
